Professional Licensure and Certification Costs:

The teacher education preparation programs both undergraduate and graduate, require the student to pass the content test prior to their final semester in which student teaching occurs. The cost is \$122. That cost will be added to teacher candidate students in the term prior to student teaching.

Students enrolled in the alternative licensure program are required to pass the content test as well as pay application fee and licensure costs in their first semester. \$250 will be added to their first semester cost of attendance.
